

Terms and Conditions of Use

1. Copyright of the website and its contents vests in the Company.
2. Data entered into the site is only the data that is essential for the operation of the activities to be performed and the challenges made. Care has been taken to ensure that Student data can only be accessed by the Student or their class Teacher.
